



About Fun on the Farm

General Description:

This educational program series provides an opportunity for children *and* adults in the community to learn more about life on the farm and conservation practices through hands-on learning experiences. Participants will visit four different farms that we have in Clarion County. Each program will begin with an interactive overview on the type of farm we are at and will end with a tour of the farm given by the farmer(s). Carpooling is encouraged.

Ages: 5 & Up. Family-friendly.

Fee: \$15/person if attending all programs (\$5/person/individual programs)

What to Bring: wear clothes you are not afraid to get dirty, rain boots or old sneakers, water bottle, **jackets and umbrellas depending on the weather**

Thursday, Sept. 7th (5-6:30pm)



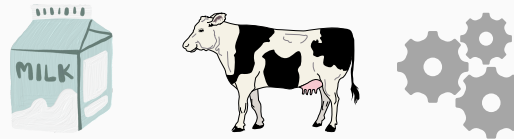
Topic: Honey

Location: Steve's Bees (Lucinda, PA)

Participants will:

- Learn about pollinators, including Pennsylvania natives, and the important process of pollination.
- Taste local honey & learn all about beekeeping with a tour of the farm.
- Take action to help "save the bees" and other pollinators by planting a native flower to take home.

Thursday, Sept. 14th (5-6:30pm)



Topic: Dairy Farm Robotics

Location: Nexgen Dairy at Sweet Breeze Farms (Mayport, PA)

Participants will:

- Participate in a robotic arm STEM activity & watch dairy farm robots in action.
- Engage in hands-on activities and tour the farm to learn about the basics of dairy farming.
- Learn about the importance of proper manure management.

Thursday, Sept.21st (5-6:30pm)



Topic: Potatoes

Location: Long Acres Potato Farm (Tionesta, PA)

Participants will:

- Learn about root vegetables and the benefits of healthy soil.
- Build a clock that is powered by potatoes in a hands-on STEM activity.
- Help dig up potatoes and tour the farm to learn all about potato farming.

Topic: Fruits, Veggies, & Flowers

Location: Zacherl's Farm Market & Greenhouse (Shippenville, PA)

Participants will:

- Participate in hands-on activities to learn about how crops and flowers grow.
- Go on a hayride and tour the many crops that are grown by Zacherl's.
- Engage in a DIY Biodegradable Corn Plastic STEM activity.
